This was a pivotal year for MOBIUS as our original host institution, the University of Missouri system, changed from a managed cluster to a standalone system. Careful consideration to the process and timing of the change were paramount to MOBIUS and the University. This change in status was a big financial loss to MOBIUS. But, by working together and coordinating the process, we were able to negotiate a new contract with Innovative for MOBIUS that kept our organization together and the University was able to negotiate their own contract with Innovative. MOBIUS staff were able to assist MU staff with their transition within their timeframe. our contract gave us a much needed cost savings but with a new suite of products, and MU was able to move forward as a standalone institution and continue as a valuable member of MOBIUS.

As part of our new contract with Innovative, we received a new suite of products for all of our cluster member libraries, many of who had not purchased any new products in years. Some of the notable new products included a proxy server-Web Access Management, a link resolver-WebBridge, ERM & KnowledgeBase, and a statistics database, Decision Center.

Also as part of our new contract, to save money, we agreed to merge four clusters. Lance and Quest merged to become Avalon going live on October 18, 2017. Kansas City and Towers merged to become KC-Towers going live on August 23, 2017.

ArticleReach Direct was purchased with our new Innovative contract and implementation began in 2016. ArticleReach Direct is a resource sharing system that allows for direct borrowing of non-returnables. This was an opt-in product for our libraries.

Encore was added as a discovery solution to the MOBIUS Union Catalog in July 2016. Our searchmobius.org URL was redirected to the Encore version of the union catalog. The traditional webpac was made available as the classic catalog.

We continued our trend of adding new member libraries to MOBIUS. This year we added two new lowa libraries. West Des Moines Public Library went live in September 2016 and Altoona Public Library went live in December 2016 as our first Polaris Library using the API to Inn-Reach.

In order to share materials with the Iowa libraries, MOBIUS began a 3 day per week courier connection

between Missouri and Iowa. We also signed a contract to start managing the courier service for the Rivershare Libraries, a Polaris consortium in Iowa and for the Iowa Library Alliance, an alliance meant to form a statewide courier system.

The Task Force on the Impact and Value of Membership was created. A new brochure was created to be used with administrators and upper level management to show the value of MOBIUS.

As an expansion of our services, MOBIUS joined the Open Textbook Network on behalf of our member libraries in June 2017. OTN is an alliance of hundreds of colleges, universities, and consortia partners working together to advance the use of open textbooks in higher education. System Leaders, Christina Virden, MOBIUS E-Resources Coordinator, and Grace Atkins, Outreach & OER Librarian, University of Missouri-Columbia, serve as the main point of contact for Campus Leader training and support for this program.



MOBIUS entered another contract year with the Missouri State Library to host and manage the Missouri Evergreen Consortium on September 1, 2016. It was another productive and busy year and continues to be an exciting time to be a part of this open-source resource-sharing consortium, as it grows and matures. In MOBIUS FY 2017, Jefferson County and Festus Public Libraries joined the consortium and migrated onto the Evergreen ILS to begin resource sharing. In addition, Texas County, Trails Regional, Livingston County, Douglas County, Mountain View Public, and North Kansas City Public Libraries all joined the consortium to migrate in FY 2018. In June 2017, Missouri Evergreen comprised almost 40 member systems representing over 80 locations, and containing almost 2 million items, over 1 million bibliographic records, and over 388,000 patrons. According to the State Library, it represents the third largest public library system/public library consortium in the State for physical collection size and number of borrowers. Also, according to a fact sheet from the State Library, "In 2016, the number of requests made in Missouri Evergreen was only 7% lower than the number of Interlibrary Loan requests made statewide in OCLC. The number of requests filled was 10% higher."

Missouri Evergreen became a non-profit organization and updated its bylaws and policies to conform with necessary standards. The membership continued meeting bi-monthly, and the membership's cataloging and circulation committees continued to meet regularly, others as needed. The membership met in-person at the Missouri Library Association Conference in October 2016 and at the Missouri Public Library Directors meetings in December 2016 and June 2017. The consortium and MOBIUS staff continued efforts to recruit new members. At the June 2017 membership meeting/annual business meeting, the consortium approved two new Executive Committee members for threeyear terms and the Executive Committee chose new officers for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. Other discussion about the issues and procedures of the consortium also took place. A couple libraries hosted regional refresher trainings open to all consortium members and were well attended.

The consortium set up an Authority Control Task Force to explore adding authority control to Missouri Evergreen and to set up a request for bids and evaluate the responses. The Cataloging Committee continued to work with MOBIUS staff on catalog cleanup and deduplication efforts

and scripting. The Circulation Committee met regularly to discuss issues and questions related to circulation staff functions. The consortium also established a Reports Interest Group which will begin meeting in FY2018.

In November, Missouri Evergreen servers shifted to use Google container technology rather than hosting locally on servers at ISG Technology. This move allowed the ILS service to be more flexible

in terms of hardware in order to meet future demand. The container technology is faster and more reliable than the traditional ownership of physical servers and provides redundant networking, redundant virtual machines, redundant database servers and ensures high availability. Missouri Evergreen also upgraded from Evergreen version 2.9.1 to version 2.11.0 when moving to the cloud servers. MOBIUS is the first organization to utilize the docker container technology for an Evergreen system.

MOBIUS Missouri Evergreen staff participated in the larger Evergreen community by contributing quite a number of bug fixes and software patches, adding new coding based on features requested by Missouri Evergreen members, participating in committees, adding documentation, participating in discussions, hosting sandboxes for community "bug squashing days," and attending at the International Evergreen Conference (held in April in Covington, KY). Blake presented a program at the conference on using docker containers and cloud hosting. MOBIUS also submitted a proposal to host the 2018 conference at the St. Charles Convention Center and was selected and began planning for the conference.

MOBIUS staff had the opportunity in November to meet with a visiting librarian from China to talk about Evergreen and Missouri Evergreen.

MOBIUS Missouri Evergreen staff, Blake Graham-Henderson and Debbie Luchenbill, performed myriad tasks, including: help desk; communication with members and potential members; training--on new features, at new libraries, and for new directors/staff members; aforementioned system upgrades; system setup and migrations; customized OPACs; software development; creating helpful videos; creating training documentation; administrative tasks; writing contract reports and other updates about the consortium; visiting member and potential member libraries; creating or updating report templates; and updates to the Missouri Evergreen website. MOBIUS staff also began working on the next year's contract with the Missouri State Library, which continues into FY2018.
