Introduction

This schedule of charges includes the following:

- Fees for services and products that are not included in MOBIUS annual membership fee and assessments
- Fees for services and products available to non-members
- Fees for new members of MOBIUS

Additional Delivery Stops

The cost of the delivery stop to the main library is included in the membership fee for each member. However, a member may request additional delivery stops at 5 or fewer days per week at additional locations, such as branch libraries. All of the following fees are based on the number of delivery stops per week for an entire year, exclusive of national holidays and library-determined closures. Partial years are pro-rated.

- 5 stops per week \$3,563/year
- 4 stops per week \$2,850/year
- 3 stops per week \$2,138/year
- 2 stops per week \$1,425/year
- 1 stop per week \$ 713/year

Licensing of Electronic Databases

MOBIUS negotiates licenses for electronic databases on behalf of member libraries to maximize the value of consortial licensing. An administrative fee may be added to such products.

Implementation of New Innovative Interfaces, Inc. Modules

Member libraries who decide to implement a new, or new to them, Innovative Interfaces, Inc. system module should contact the MOBIUS Executive Director. A quote will be provided for the implementation of a new module based upon the number of hours involved to implement and train the requesting library. The quote will also include the cost of annual software maintenance for the first year of operation.

Implementation of New Systems

A library, or group of libraries, interested in becoming members of MOBIUS and participating in the MOBIUS Union Catalog should contact the MOBIUS Executive Director for more information. The cost of membership depends on a number of factors, including whether or not the library(ies) choose to have MOBIUS host or manage their local catalog(s).

A current member library interested in acquiring a new local system with continued participation in the MOBIUS Union Catalog should contact the MOBIUS Executive Director for more information on MOBIUS' ability to host, manage, and/or support the new system.

Implementation of New Non-Innovative Products or Services

Member libraries that decide to implement a new (or new to them) product or service that requires the assistance of MOBIUS staff should contact the MOBIUS Executive Director. A quote will be provided for the implementation of a new product or service based upon the number of hours involved to implement and train the requesting library.

Rates

The MOBIUS Board of Directors approved a \$50 hourly rate on April 23, 2010.
